

Dear Parent / Carer

Lancashire Constabulary with Blackburn with Darwen Borough Council are working with your child's school to teach pupils about road safety.

Some pupils are due to receive practical training in both identifying and using safe places to cross, the importance of being bright and being seen as well as the Green Cross Code.

Whilst the children will have actively taken part in this activity, it is vital that these messages continue in their everyday travel and we would like to encourage you to take part in the practical homework that will be set. We are asking all parents/carers to familiarise themselves with the Green Cross Code and actively use safe crossing places with your child (holding hands at all times).

Information will be provided and we would be grateful if you could add the location and date that you used the crossings onto the worksheet and return it to school. This can be done on any journey and should encourage conversation around road safety and the key messages that your child has learnt.

Also, during this week if your child returns home with a sticker, they have been measured and provided with information to try and ensure that they are being transported correctly. Please check that it matches your travel choices and if you are still unsure then please visit Child Seat Safety Limited (childseatsafety.co.uk) who have lots of information and helpful advice on in car safety.
